

SWRLS CIO Members' Day 2019, Call for Papers

SWRLS CIO Members' Day is an opportunity for members to network to hear about and learn from exciting projects and initiatives taking place in the region's library services. These may be small one-off initiatives or larger scale projects with several partners, but all will have relevance to other services.

The Board of Trustees is now planning the next Members' Day and is inviting members to submit ideas for presentations. Details as follows:

Date: Thursday 25 April, 2019, 10.30 - 15.30.

Venue: University of the West of England.

Expenses: reasonable travel expenses will be paid, if required, and lunch will be provided on the day.

Presentations: around 15 - 20 minutes on projects and initiatives taking place in library services. These could be:

- initiatives involving one library or multi partner projects;
- working with and delivering directly to customers or a workforce development initiative or working with other departments in your organisation or external, including non-library, partners;
- single sector or cross sector;
- just started, on-going or recently completed (i.e. within the last year).

How you deliver your presentation is down to you - a data projector will be available, but a 15 minute talk is just as acceptable. We want to hear about what you are doing or did, what you are learning, any feedback from staff and/or customers and how this could be replicated elsewhere.

We would love to hear from you and include you in our programme. Even in these difficult times, there are wonderful projects taking place - let's spread the good news and learn from one another.
