Directions/Location/Access

Rail

Exeter is served by two main line stations. Exeter Central Station is within easy walking distance of the library and Exeter St Davids is located a mile from the city centre. It is possible to take a taxi or city centre bus. Change trains at Exeter St Davids for Exeter Central, or if you are feeling energetic, enjoy a walk into the city.

Bus & Coach

The main bus and coach station is situated about half a mile away, within easy reach of the library.

Car and Park and Ride

Exeter is served by three park and ride schemes. Visitors approaching from East Devon and the M5 should use the park and ride at **Sowton** located on the approach road to Middlemore from junction 30 or the **Honiton Road** site accessed from the roundabout at end of A30 and off the M5 at junction 29.

Visitors from Plymouth and West Devon should use the park and ride at Matford located on Bad Homburg Way just off the Devon Hotel Roundabout. However, there are also a number of pay and display car parks within easy reach of the Central Library.
